Face Dance, Face Drama, and Face Voice are additional programmes for dancers, actors and singers looking to hone specific skills in those areas outside of Face Academy's musical theatre training.

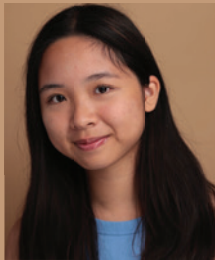
